Join Us

Open Mornings

We hold Open Mornings every term and they are the perfect opportunity for families to come and tour the school, meet our pupils, parents and staff.

Admissions


Prospective parents are invited to visit, either on an Open Morning or on an alternative day which suits them, when they will be given a tour of the school, by a Senior boy, have an opportunity to see the school in action and meet the Headmaster and SENCo if necessary.

Assessment Day

All our prospective pupils are invited to attend an Assessment Day. The boys will have the opportunity to experience a day in their future class with their peer group. As well as informal tests we will consider his overall suitability to ensure we can offer the appropriate environment. We contact parents to give feedback and the offer of a place within 24 hours.

Academic Scholarships

Academic Scholarships are awarded for entry into Year 3. Examination takes place in November the year prior to entry and are open to both internal and external candidates.



Location

Kingswood House is in an excellent location with easy access by road and rail. Situated on West Hill, the school is just on the outskirts of Epsom town centre with the railway station a 10 minute walk away.

We have three minibuses that transport pupils to Kingswood House each morning. The children are collected at designated pick-up points.



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
