Our Vision

The School will be making a substantial financial investment into this exciting development.

Our first project will be to build the Junior School at a cost of approximately £750,000. This will be followed by a new Pre-Prep Department which will cost in the region of £500,000 and later the Humanities classrooms at a cost of approximately £250,000.



Enriching the experience

In addition we would like to transform the sporting facilities with a new Sports Hall at a cost of approximately £600,000.

The Sports Hall will be complemented by an indoor swimming pool, which will be built at a cost of approximately £400,000.

Gift Aid
