

## **Kingswood Active Easter 2021 guidelines for parents.**

Dates:

- 29 March – 1 April
- 12 – 16 April

In the Easter holidays we will reopen Kingswood Active to Children. We want this to be an enjoyable and safe experience for children, parents and staff so please ensure that you read this guide carefully and adhere to all procedures.

This guide intends to give parents and children a clear overview of the 'new' day at Kingswood Active and must be read in conjunction with ***'Summary of preventative measures for a phased return to KHS'***.

Please note that procedures are subject to change.

### **Clothing and equipment**

Children can come to school in their own clothes and sun hat. If sun cream is needed, it should be applied at home before school begins. Children are to bring their lunch in a marked box and have a water bottle. Children are not to bring in their own toys and equipment, this will minimise the transition of all objects between home and school. No bikes or scooters - **only** items mentioned above are allowed to travel between home and school.

### **Drop off**

Boys need to be dropped off between 0830 and 0845 at the front of the school. Staff will be available to open the gate and send children to their bubble classroom, while observing social distancing markers on the ground. Parents will not be allowed on the school premises and should only be present for the time required to drop off and pick up their child.

### **Pick Up**

Children will be escorted to the front gate at 15:55 for collection at 1600. There will be markings on the ground showing where the boys are to stand while waiting to be picked up. A member of staff whose responsibility it will be to see them off safely will escort each group. Parents will need to be patient because boys must be excused one at a time.

## **Facilities**

Children will register and be based in groups which are age appropriate and with friends where appropriate. Children will not be able to change groups. We will use the following indoor setting for each group:

Group 1 - Year 4 classrooms

Group 2 - Langlands Hall

Most rooms have large bi-fold which, when opened double the room size and desks will be spread out accordingly. All rooms are equipped with separate bins for tissues and a range of cleaning products. The school will be cleaned at various times throughout the school day.

There will be a dedicated outside space as well for each group.

## **Bubbles**

In order to prevent the possible transmission of the virus, groups are to be kept to a maximum of 25 children. Children are to remain in the same bubble for the whole of the day. Bubbles will not mix at any point during the day.

## **Registration & activities**

On arrival, children must go to their classroom immediately. Children will be assigned an area to put their lunch boxes and water bottles must be kept on the floor next to them. Any discarded tracksuits must be placed on the back of chairs.

Children will have most of their indoor activities in the same classroom every day and staff will come to them. However if we use different locations then classrooms will be cleaned before and after use.

## **Structure**

There will be a variety of activities throughout the day ranging from arts and crafts, computers, I-Pads, a wide variety of outside sports and games. The day will be similar to a normal 'on-site' Kingswood Active Day but we will work in smaller, structured groups.

### **Possible activities:**

- Arts and crafts including specific projects to take home
- Games consoles that will be cleaned regularly
- I-Pads that will be cleaned regularly
- Variety of outdoor sports including the use of school equipment that again will be cleaned regularly
- Latest films screened on large screen
- Lego and other construction materials
- Team games in bubble groups observing social distancing guidelines
- Use of Dt room
- Use of IT suite

### **Toilets, Break times and lunch**

Members of staff will ensure that boys wash their hands regularly throughout the day. Bubbles will not be allowed to mix and in the first instance, each one will have their own toilet block.

During break times, children will be allowed to play in designated areas only and these will be clearly marked. Each bubble will play separately and they will have their own equipment that can only be used by that bubble.

Children need to bring their lunches in marked lunch boxes with and ice/cool bag to keep it cool. It will not be practical or safe to store boxes in the school fridge.

We hope to have lunch outdoors each day. Each bubble will have its own designated area in which to eat. If wet, children will eat their lunches in their own bubble classroom.
