Dear Parents,

School Fees 2022- 2023

As usual and always before the Easter break, the Governors have recently completed a detailed annual review of the school budget for the next academic year.

It would be fair to say that over the last two challenging years, all within the school have pulled together and gone to extraordinary lengths to provide the best possible high-quality education for our pupils. Despite the ongoing hardships and crises facing many of our families, you, the parents, have been quite magnificent in giving your wholehearted continued support to Kingswood House and for this I thank you.

Over this time, and in spite of the obvious difficulties the school has continued to be forward looking and to plan for and invest in its future, and by doing so, ensuring that the Kingswood House offer to your children and indeed to you as parents, is both attractive and highly competitive.

The last two years has seen the historic move up to aged 16 further established, while the introduction of co-education in September 2021 has also been extremely successful. Parental interest in the school as a direct result of these positive strategic decisions continues to grow. We have continued to make essential investments in facilities, resources and the academic staff, as well as more obvious developments such as the renewal of the all-weather pitch, significant investment in ICT and additional aesthetic upgrades, which you will have seen around the school and within the grounds. With the steady growth of the school, important projects planned for the year ahead include totally upgrading our catering facilities, not necessarily glamorous, but now essential.

In reviewing the school's budget for the forthcoming academic year, we have cut as much expenditure as we possibly can, while also maintaining high quality and still achieving the school's key objectives and values. Yet as I am sure you will also appreciate, some cost increases in the current economic climate are both inevitable and unfortunately also out of our control.
