

Sports Information - Summer Term 2022

In this letter, you will find important sports information for the forthcoming term. Please read this carefully, and contact me if you have any queries.

Kit

Pupils will be required to come into school in their PE or Games kit on the days they have PE or Games. **Please ensure that ALL pupils wear their full tracksuit (top & bottoms, no black tracksuit bottoms) on these days! We want pupils to look smart when arriving and leaving school and when sitting in lessons.** Black Skins & T-shirts may be worn under their kit, but tracksuits will not be allowed to be worn in muddy activities. Further Kit Information

Cricket whites are only to be worn during fixtures and not during PE & Games Lessons.

Fixtures

If your child is selected to represent the school in a **cricket fixture**, they will be required to wear cricket whites (shirt & trousers) or their white PE kit. These can be school, club or plain cricket whites.

Labelling & Naming Kit

Please help the Sports Department by labelling **all** of your child's sports kit before the return to school. This will help us with lost property.

The table below shows where to label your child's kit, with initial and surname (e.g. F. Bloggs) or with sew-in labels. It also indicates required kit for PE and Games.

Games Afternoon Extra Equipment:

This term we are changing sports and all pupils will need to have the following equipment for their chosen sports:

Sport	Extra Equipment
Cricket	Bats, Pads, Gloves & boxes
Tennis	Rackets
Badminton/Squash	Clear or white soled trainers, rackets
Golf (Years 9-11)	Golf Clubs

Please note that the school does have supplies of equipment for all the sports above, but only has a limited supply. We encourage pupils to bring their own equipment, which can be stored safely at school in the sports shed during the school day.

Kit Supplies

We know there have been some issues with sourcing kit from our suppliers. If this is the case, please let us know and send your child in wearing kit similar and as close to the KHS kit as possible. For example, plain black shorts are suitable if you do not have the KHS shorts.

While allowing for supply shortages, it is important we maintain high standards. Failure to have the correct kit for either lesson will result in a kit mark. If your child receives three kit marks in a half-term period, they will receive a PE detention in a Tuesday or Thursday morning break.

Sports Practice

After-school sports practice allows pupils extra time to develop their skills. This is open to every child in the school and there is **no need to sign up**; pupils can simply turn up and play.

If your child wishes to represent the school in the A & B teams this year, they should make every effort to come to as many sports practices as possible.

The sports practice rota is as follows:

If it is necessary to cancel sports practice, all pupils will be sent to prep. They will be available for collection at 1700.

Team Sheets & Fixtures

This term, there will be many matches against a variety of different schools, across all age groups.

Team sheets will be issued at least 48 hours before the fixture and we will send these out via Parentmail. Our intention is to include as many children as possible in fixtures, and we expect your child to play if selected to represent the school.

Year 2-4 Swimming

This term we have managed to secure a slot at Epsom College swimming pool on Monday mornings at 1115-1200.

We will be taking all pupils in year 2, 3 and 4 for swimming during this time and this will replace their games lesson on a Tuesday morning.

We would ask the children to come to school wearing their swimming costumes under their tracksuits on Mondays, with their uniform in their kit bags to change into after swimming.

This will run throughout the entire term, which will give the pupils a great opportunity to develop.
