In this letter, you will find important sports information for the forthcoming term. May I ask that you read this carefully, and contact me if you have any queries.

PE & Games Lessons 2022/23

From Year 2 to Year 8, each class will have one PE lesson a week and several Games lessons. GCSE PE pupils will have three lessons a week, which will include theory and practical lessons. All pupils in Years 9 to 11 will have three Games lessons.

Kit

As mentioned in Mr Murphy's letter, pupils will be required to come into school in their PE or Games kit on the days they have PE or Games. The table below details when your children will have PE and Games lessons:

It is very important that the pupils turn up in the correct kit, looking as smart as possible on the days mentioned above.

Labelling Kit & Lost Property

Please help the Sports Department by labelling **all** of your child's sports kit before the return to school. This will help us with lost property.

All **lost property** will be stored in the sports room. The PE Staff will return any labelled item to the pupil. If not labelled, items will remain in the sports rooms until the end of term, where after it will be given to second hand uniform for resale.

The table below shows where to label your child's kit, with initial and surname (e.g. F. Bloggs) or with sew-in labels. It also indicates required kit for PE and Games.

All pupils should expect games lessons to be on grass and should bring their boots to every Lesson

We know there have been some issues with sourcing kit from our suppliers. If this is the case, please let us know and send your child in wearing kit similar and as close to the KHS kit as possible. For example, plain black shorts are suitable if you do not have the KHS shorts.

While allowing for supply shortages, it is important we maintain high standards. Failure to have the correct kit for either lesson will result in a kit mark. If your child receives three kit marks in a half-term period, they will receive a PE detention in a Tuesday or Thursday morning break.

Pupils are not permitted to wear blazers over PE or Games kit; they may wear fleeces or coats as appropriate.

Sports Practice

After-school sports practice allows pupils extra time to develop their skills. This is open to every child in the school and there is no need to sign up; pupils can simply turn up and play.

If your child wishes to represent the school in the A & B teams this year, they should make every effort to come to as many sports practices as possible.

The sports practice rota is as follows:

Pupils are welcome to wear their own sports clothing if sports practice is on a different day to their PE or Games days.

If it is necessary to cancel sports practice, all pupils will be sent to prep. They will be available for collection at 1700.

Team Sheets & Fixtures

This term, we are looking forward to continuing fixtures. There will be many matches against a variety of different schools, across all age groups and sports.

Team sheets will be issued at least 48 hours before the fixture and we will send these out via Parentmail and will be posted in the Sports Room.

Our intention is to include as many children as possible in fixtures, and we expect your child to play if selected to represent the school.
